Fire performance

The most common application for door closers is on fire doors. An area where performance and reliability are essential, it is reassuring to know that Powermatic satisfies all relevant fire performance standards, including:

- CE marked
- Successfully type-tested to BS EN 1154: 1997 power size 3
- BS EN 1634-1 fire tested for one-hour and half-hour fire doors
- BS EN 1634-1 fire tested for four-hour steel fire doors
- BS 476 fire tested for one-hour and half-hour fire doors
- The only Certifire jamb-mounted door closer



Accessibility

Where door closers are concerned, opening forces for doors are stipulated by BS 8300: 2009 and the various regional Building Regulations. The door closer's ability to facilitate compliance with these standards is determined by its efficiency in operation.

Powermatic is the only jamb-mounted door closer to offer the operating efficiencies required to assure this.

Furthermore, Powermatic's opening forces have been independently certified as meeting the requirements of BS EN 1154.

- Ultra-efficient (exceeds threshold of 55% efficiency)
- Contributes towards achievement of BS 8300: 2009 and regional Building Regulations* unlike single spring door closers.

*Approved Document M (ADM) in England and Wales, Section 4 in Scotland and Part R in Northern Ireland. These regulations apply to the entire doorset in-situ and, therefore, no door closer can claim compliance on its own. Single spring door closers cannot achieve this due to inherent weaknesses in operating efficiencies.



Safety

Door closers play a vital role in the safety and comfort of a building. If a door closer fails, or is damaged, it can prevent the entire fire door from working. The consequences can be, at best, inconvenient, and at worst, fatal; a fire door that does not close properly against its seals will not perform its primary functions of holding fire and smoke at bay.

The fact that Powermatic is totally concealed when the door is closed makes it much less likely to be vandalised or tampered with, therby assuring continuous service. In addition, Powermatic's key mechanisms are concealed within the door itself, further enhancing its resistance to damage.



Aesthetics

The very obvious control boxes and arms of surface mounted door closers have a detrimental effect on the overall appearance of interiors and can create a functional, institutionalised environment, which can impact on the occupants' comfort and sense of homeliness.
